Highlights:

- All funds now sit with HSBC, and we shall be setting up a high interest account with £8,000 on deposit on a rolling six-month basis. Sue Tiplady and Charlie Gray have access to the HSBC Business Account App to enable them to pay invoices.
- Pool fees have increased substantially and, approximately one hundred fewer swim sessions were booked over the year. Consequently, sessions ran at a £400 loss which has been subsidised by membership fees.
- We have twenty fewer members compared to last year, which has impacted income by £600.
- There are plenty of funds in reserve, so the club is not at risk, but it would be preferable if training sessions cost were covered by attendance.
